Ancient Halasarna Project, Kos (2007-2015): study and publication of all the Bronze Age to Classical finds from the excavation conducted at the sanctuary area of ancient Halasarna in collaboration to M. Koutsoumbou (*Thales Programmes*- EU funding).

Symi Archaeological Project (2012-2013): I have co-directed this programme which aimed to study the Archaic, Classical, Hellenistic and Roman phases of this island. Part of this project is the research conducted on the island's caves in 2013 in collaboration with Dr F. Mavridis (Ephorate of Speleology and Palaeoanthropology, Greek Ministry of Culture).

Halasarna Survey Project, Kos (2005-2009): study and publication of the Prehistoric material from the survey. This project has been in collaboration with the University of Athens and has been funded by the European Union (*Pythagoras Programme*).

Leska Archaeological Project, Kythera (2011-2017): I have co-directed this project with entailed a small-scale systematic surface survey and the excavation of a Minoan peak sanctuary at Mt Mermigkari on the Leska top, in collaboration with the 26th Prehistoric and Classical Ephorate of the Greek Ministry of Culture. Furthermore, I have co-directed part of this project in collaboration with Dr G. Kefalidou and Dr S. Anand (*Horizon Programme*, University of Nottingham). At the moment I am studying the material from this Project aiming at publishing a monograph.

TRANSMED (2019-2022): I will be comparing the results from different survey projects across the Mediterranean in order to emphasise the common elements that the Greek colonists brought to their new homelands.

Archaeological Project at Abdera and Xanthi (APAX) (2015-2023): I am co-directing this programme along with Dr N. Kalintzi (Ephoria of Xanthi), Dr E. Kefalidou (University of Athens) and Dr Y. Xydopoulos (University of Thessaloniki) which aims at conducting an archaeological research in the area of Xanthi. This project entails the conduct of a systematic survey, geophysical analyses and excavations in various parts of the region under study. The results of APAX will be presented in co-authored books.

CURRENT RESEARCH

Pottery analysis of Neolithic and EBA pottery at Fthiotis and Palamari (2018-2024): it includes three programmes, one at *Koutroulou Magoula* under the directions of Dr N. Kyparissi-Apostolika and Dr Y. Hamilakis where I will be studying the ceramic vessels with Dr S. Katsarou-Tzeveleki. The other is Neolithic *Ayios Vlasios* where I will be co-directing the excavation project along with Ms S. Dimaki and the third is the restudy of Neolithic material from excavations conducted in the Lokris area. I am in charge of studying the EB I-III early pottery from the site of Palamari.

The Grevena Archaeological Project (2020-2024): I am co-directing along with Ms S. Dimaki (Grevena Ephoria) and Dr H. Orenge (ICAC) an archaeological project that involves a systematic intensive survey and excavation in specific prehistoric locations. I will be responsible for the fieldwork aspect of this project and the analysis of the Neolithic and the LBA material, which has a strong Mycenaean character.

The Krannona Survey (2022-2026): I am co-directing along the systematic survey conducted as part of the Krannona Archaeological Project, which is directed by Prof. D. Bonsakis (University of Crete).

Analysis of Minoan Finds (2024): I have collaborated with Prof. C. Tsigonaki in studying Minoan remains from University of Crete excavations, Eleutherna in Rethymno and Oxa in Lasithi.
