

Palaeolithic Seminar 2023 - 2024

The Palaeolithic Seminar is embarking on a new cycle, co-organised by the University of Crete and the Ephorate of Palaeoanthropology and Speleology in the Ministry of Culture. Lectures are being organized on the occasion of the exhibition *The Origins of Sculpture:* Archaeological Finds from the Old World and Lesbos 2.5 million to 50,000 Years Before Present, currently being presented at the Benaki Museum of Greek Culture (27-09-2023 to 07-01-2024) by the University of Crete, the Benaki Museum and the Region of Crete, in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture.

The seminar will bring speakers from around the world to Athens, including experts in archaeology, palaeontology, and cognitive science, to present the journey taken by sculpture from its very early steps in the Paleolithic period. These lectures will not only trigger a reconsideration of the origins of human culture but will also highlight the dynamic cognitive processes that accompanied our ancestral species on their journey of aesthetic exploration and the achievement of form.

Professor Wynn and Professor Papadopoulos will trace the meeting points between archaeology and cognitive science. Professor Galanidou and Dr. Zipfel will talk about the archaeological sites where some of the earliest and most astonishing finds of the exhibition have come to light, challenging us to approach archaeological finds as examples of aesthetic awakening.
