IN A NUTSHELL

History Student's Scientific Society at the Jagiellonian University, Student Council of the Faculty of History at the Jagiellonian University and Polish Historical Association – Branch in Krakow hereby issue a call for papers for the III Cracovian Congress of History Students in Krakow, Poland, May 8–10, 2025.

This event is the meeting place of history students from different countries and cultures. Its first edition was held in 2019. During the three working days, papers are presented by participants, each session moderated by a chair.

The title of this year's edition is "Rebellions, Uprisings and

Revolutions throughout the Ages".

From ancient revolts to modern revolutions, human history is filled with moments of radical change. Rebellions, uprisings, and revolutions have always shaped the history of humanity, transforming societies, changing political systems, and influencing the economy and culture worldwide. The Congress aims to explore these pivotal events, examining the social, political, and economic and cultural factors that sparked rebellions, uprisings and revolutions, as well as their lasting impact on national and global scales.

IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

The conference fee is 70€ (foreign students) / 300 PLN (polish students).

We intend to cover the costs of accommodation (4 nights), meals, as well as cultural and academic programmes.

We do not cover travel costs.

During the Congress, we offer free trips to museums and other cultural facilities in Krakow. We also plan numerous integration meetings.

The deadline for submitting applications is March 23, 2025.

You will receive a notification regarding your qualification to participate in the Congress by March 31, 2025, in your email inbox.

TECHNICAL ASPECTS

The abstract that is due on March 23, 2025 must be written in English.

Prelections only in English.

Presentation time: 20 minutes + session discussion.

The Congress is directed towards the students and PhD students of history and other familiar disciplines.

By applying for participation in the Congress, we consider it as consent to the publication and dissemination of personal data and image in promotional materials and social media for the purpose of organization and promotion of the Congress.

THEMES AND TOPICS

The Congress themes will cover the period from the antiquity to the 21st century.

Proposed issues include but are not limited to:

- Rebellions and uprisings in ancient and medieval times;
- Major early modern revolutions (e.g., French, American, English);
- National uprisings and struggles for independence in the 19th and 20th centuries;
- Social and cultural revolutions of the 20th century (e.g., Russian, Chinese, Cuban, Protests of 1968, Sexual revolution;
- Peaceful revolutions and protests (e.g., the Velvet Revolution, Hong Kong protests);
- Contemporary protest movements (e.g., Arab Spring, climate protests, feminist movements);
- Women in revolutionary movements;
- Causes and consequences of revolutions in political, economic, and cultural dimensions.

We encourage you to formulate your own paper topic within the Congress theme.

CONGRESS OBJECTIVES

Our goal is to create a platform for interdisciplinary discussions on the major turning points in history that have dramatically altered the course of events. We aim to support young researchers in presenting their findings and establishing new academic networks. The conference will foster a deeper understanding of these critical moments and promote academic dialogue.

Additionally the Congress aims to foster the integration of students and doctoral candidates from various countries, civilizations, and cultures. It also seeks to promote Poland and Krakow as important centers of scholarship and discussion on the European and global stage. By hosting this event, we hope to highlight the rich academic tradition of our country and city, fostering collaboration and dialogue among students and young scholars from diverse backgrounds.
